Dr. Weaver is Vice President, Health Delivery Redesign, for Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Carolina (“BCBSNC”). She is responsible for identifying, developing and supporting new partnerships and models to improve the sustainability, effectiveness and affordability of healthcare.

Prior to joining BCBSNC in December of 2012, Dr. Weaver was Executive Vice President, Medical Affairs and Physician Practices, for WakeMed Health & Hospitals. Dr. Weaver joined WakeMed in 2009 and was primarily responsible for managing the operations and growth of WakeMed’s multi-specialty and primary care physician practices.

Alliance Medical provides primary medical care to the working uninsured of Wake County; the practice grew by more than 30% each year, and currently provides care for more than 10,000 local, uninsured patients.

Dr. Weaver is very active in the community and currently serves on several Boards, including, but not limited to, the Wake County Medical Society; YMCA of the Triangle; *The Wake County Physician Magazine*; Community Care of Wake and Johnston Counties; CapitalCare Collaborative; Alliance Medical Ministry; and the Managed Care Executive Group.
